




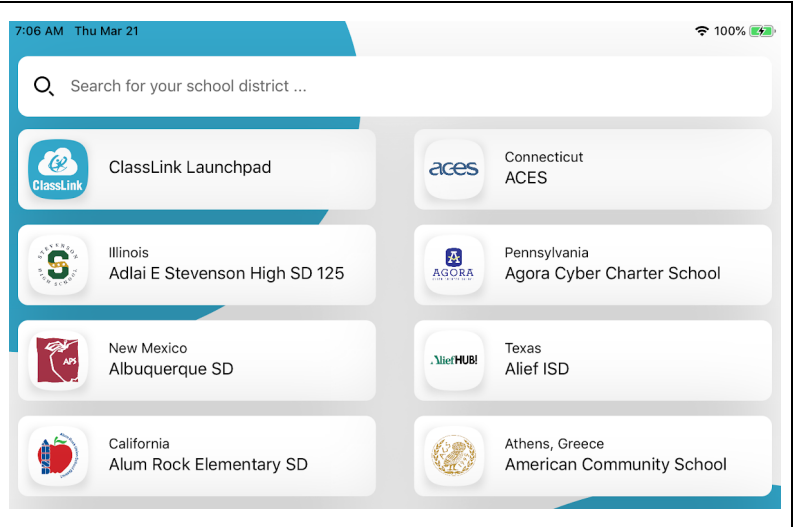
<p>1. Open the <b>App Store</b> on your iOS device (e.g. iPhones, iPads).</p>	
<p>2. Touch <b>Search</b> on the bottom of the screen.</p>	
<p>3. In the <b>Search Window</b> at the top of the screen, type "classlink launchpad."</p>	
<p>4. Touch <b>Get</b> to install the app.</p> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be sure the app looks like the image to the right. There is an old OCPS Launchpad app that will NOT work correctly.</li> <li>• You might be required to sign into your iTunes account if you have not stored your password on your device.</li> </ul>

- The password for middle and high school is selected by the student and is the same as the password they use to login to their laptop.

  - After opening a few applications, a counter will appear next to the 4 squares. This represents the number of open apps. To switch between open apps, click on that icon.



