## Attendance for FSA and NG

Attendance is very important during FSA. The Florida Department of Education instituted a rule that states if a student is absent for the 1<sup>st</sup> Session of a test, they will not be able to take the 2<sup>nd</sup> Session until the 1<sup>st</sup> is done.

Due to testing, Wednesday, **Wednesday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>, May 1<sup>st</sup>, May 8<sup>th</sup> & May 15<sup>th</sup>** **will NOT be early dismissal.** Schools will not have early release on these dates due to testing.
